- Eligible students must have completed at least one year in the Joint Engineering Program.
- Mechatronics students and 2+2 students are eligible.
- Scholarships are typically divided between Fall and Spring semesters.
- Minimum acceptable cumulative GPA is 3.0 at time of application.
- If cumulative GPA drops below 3.0, a student may become ineligible for the Spring portion of award.
- Academic Integrity will be considered as part of the application process.
- Full time enrollment is required to be eligible for an engineering scholarship.
